

# Genesis – Family: “Contention With Out & In”

*Of times, we equate God's blessing solely with good . . . prosperity . . . abundance . . . peace . . . joy . . . and more, when His greatest blessing in truth is His ever faithful presence amidst the struggles and labor of life. When we call out to Him, He is there; when we seek Him, He lets us find Him; when we try to hide . . . “behold Thou art there.” [Ps. 139:7-12] He made us demonstrate His to know Him! He uses all reveal Himself . . .*

**Context:** As his father 95 yr. previous, Abraham, Isaac has sojourned to the Gerar region due to a famine in his land. As his father, fear and lack of trust in his LORD resulted in a lie putting his wife in jeopardy and God's Name in disgrace. As with his father, Abimelech, ruler of the Philistines, confronts Isaac and sends him out from their presence . . .
