Genesis – "Jacob's Divine Appointment!" Genesis 32

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How we often *fall back on God* when we are in distress and predicaments ~ we ignore our Lord in the small things of life and then, eagerly muster our dependency upon Him as "monumental threats" advance! Yet, He is available for ALL - Matt. 11: ²⁸ "Come to Me, all *who are weary and heavy-laden, and I will give you rest. ²⁹ Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls."

[* lit. Have worked yourself to exhaustion]

We fret, we worry, we scheme - we need His rest!

Context: Jacob deceptively abandoned Laban who gave pursuit only to have the LORD come and warn him in a dream to: "Be careful that you do not speak to Jacob either good or bad." The LORD intervened! Jacob and Laban strike a covenant marked by a pile of rocks that neither is to pass by to do bad to the other as the LORD is witness. After a feast dinner, Laban arises to return home, never to see Jacob or family again . . .

Jacob left 20 years in Mesopotamia under Laban's abusive treatment. Those years were the result of his own deception/sin and running for his life "to find a wife" - of which he now has 2 and their maids. That time was not all pleasant <u>BUT NOW</u> he returns to an unknown situation that he hopes time has healed but is *unknown!* And now, Esau is coming with 400 of his men . . . internal conflict and panic!

What to do??!! Go back? Press ahead?? Turn left or right? Jacob is having a major issue - it's a "crisis of faith" and he's losing! He is striving in his own power and wisdom - not in reliance upon the One who revealed Himself, promised and has shown Himself faithful!

Every crisis of faith requires decision which determines God's participation!

What part of this passage "caught your attention"?

Is God saying something to you? What is it?

How will you respond?
